

About our paint

Recycled latex paint is a combination of interior and exterior paint. It can be used both inside and outside but lasts longer when used inside. Also, the paint contains a combination of glosses, acrylics, and enamels, so the resulting product is a low-sheen (between flat and satin) finish.

You can use a brush, roller, or paint-sprayer to apply the recycled latex paint. We recommend thoroughly mixing and filtering it prior to use. It may be additionally necessary to thin before applying it with a paint sprayer. Many painters thin the paint using a 1:3 or 1:4 water to paint ratio. Test a small portion before using.

Each 5-gallon pail covers approximately 1,000 to 1,500 square feet, depending on the application method and painting surface.

The colors at right are approximate; please visit the Highway 101 office for actual color samples.

Any unused paint can be returned to the Highway 101 Recycling Center or the Schooner Creek Transfer Station for recycling.
